***Texas Country Reporter* to Film Pacific Combat WW-II Reenactment at the National Museum of the Pacific War in Fredericksburg, Texas Reenactments to be held April 18 and 19, 2009**

WHAT: *Texas Country Reporter*, a TV program that celebrates the history, emotion and beauty that make Texas and Texans so unique will be filming an upcoming episode at the Pacific Combat Zone on Saturday, April 18. The Pacific Combat Zone is a part of the Living History Program at the National Museum of the Pacific War and presents live reenactments of a battle to capture an island in the Pacific during WW-II. Pacific Combat reenactments are presented six weekends each year with three shows each day on Saturday and Sunday.

Admission to the Pacific Combat Reenactment cost \$5.00 per person with discounts for students and seniors. WW-II veterans are admitted free of charge. Tickets must be purchased at the Pacific Combat front gate which is located at the corner of Elk and Austin streets. Admission to the main Museum is separate.

WHO: The Admiral Nimitz Foundation, operator of the National Museum of the Pacific War's Living History Program, is hosting the Pacific Combat reenactment weekends.

Bob Phillips, the *Texas Country Reporter* has traveled the back roads of Texas since 1972 telling the stories of real Texans - ordinary people doing extraordinary things. He will be telling the story of Marvin Schroeder, a Fredericksburg native who is the Director of the Living History Program at the National Museum of the Pacific War.

WHEN: Saturday, April 18 and Sunday, April 19. Show times are 10:00 a.m., 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.

WHERE: The Pacific Combat Zone is located at the corner of Elk and Austin streets in Fredericksburg, TX. The main Museum entrance is located at 340 East Main Street.
